- Participate in site/project training programs to be proficient, knowledgeable and up to date with respect to
 equipment and procedures for firefighting, medical and other emergencies.
- Participate with inspections and assessments related to Wildfire prevention duties.
- Participate in Safety/Fire Watch training
- Participate in Confined Space Entry training
- · Participate in Fall Protection training

Non-Emergency Duties

- Construct Wildfire & Spill response trailers
- Assist with the presentation of FireSmart program to First Nation Communities
- Conduct weekly/monthly maintenance/inspection duties on response equipment
