Simpcw First Nation Bursary

Bursary opportunities are available to any on-reserve band or community member or off-reserve band member*, enrolled in grade twelve (12), who can show interest on going to a full-time program at an accredited college or university in Canada leading to a certificate, diploma or degree. The candidate must also have a minimum of a 2.75 grade point average or a C+ average.

All applicants must:

1. Produce most recent transcripts from their attending Secondary School.
2. Submit an essay (see below for requirements)
3. Produce two (2) letters of reference including:
 - ↳ One (1) academic letter of reference
 - ↳ One (1) personal, non-family, letter of reference supporting the applicant's connection to the Simpcw community.
