All Eligible Voters will receive a mailed package sent to their last known address containing instructions on how to vote, a mail-in ballot package and a PIN for voting online or by telephone. If you do not receive this package by October 3, 2025, please contact the Electoral Officer.

Date: October 26, 2025


Time: 10:00am to 5:00pm
